depth of 12ft and turning end depth of 3.5ft. The facility has a Colorado timing system and one (1) lane scoreboard display. Touch pads will be used at the bock end of the pool. Hy-Tek Meet Manager software will be used throughout the meet. Limited on-deck bleacher seating within the pool is available for spectators. Weather permitting, teams and family members will be set up outside. Please be sure to bring team tents for your comfort. A full concession area will be available. If weather is not cooperative, teams will be set up in the gymnasium just past the pool. The community room across from the pool will be used for meetings. A hospitality room will be available to coaches just off of the pool deck. Parking at the YWCA is tight. We are looking into parking alternatives and will send out further parking instructions via email to coaches and team

Entries: This meet is open to all CASL Division A swimmers who have competed in a minimum

of 50% of their team's league meets through the course of the 2012 season (3). Each swimmer may be entered and compete in a <u>maximum</u> of three (3) events (individuals and

relays). The swimmer's age will be determined as of June 1, 2012.

All entries must be emailed to Megan Maslowski at sharkscoaches@gmail.com. All entry times should be in meters. If no times are available from this season, enter NT in

the space provided.

The deadline to submit entries is Saturday, July 14, 2012.

Doors Open: The facility will open at 7:00 am for entry. All athletes, coaches, spectators, and

volunteers are asked to enter through the main entrance of the YWCA. Signs will be

posted for team set up, locker rooms, etc.

Admission: \$2.00 for adults. Children under the age of 12 admitted at no charge. Meet volunteers

may pick up their ID badges and will not be charged an admission fee. Coaches may

check-in and pick up their team packets as well.

Programs: \$3.00 each. Highlighters may also be purchased for \$1.00.

Concessions: A variety of food and beverage items will be available throughout the day. NO FOOD

OR DRINK, other than water, will be permitted in the gymnasium, locker room, and pool

areas.

Team Entries: Per CASL guidelines, each swimmer may compete in a maximum of three (3) events. The events may be three (3) individual events, two individuals and one relay, or one individual and two relays. Listing a swimmer as an alternate (slots 5-8) on a relay does not count as an event.

> All entries must be submitted in Hy-Tek Team Manager format. Event files will be included in the email with the entry packet, and may also be downloaded www.swimcasl.org (League site) under the 2012 Division A link. Keep in mind the championship file is different from the dual meet event file.

NO TEAM WILL BE ENTERED WITHOUT A COMPLETED VOLUNTEER FORM

Psych Sheets: After receiving each team's entry file on Saturday, the meet director will email entry confirmations to each team. From the time this confirmation is sent, each team will have 24 hours to determine if their submitted information is correct or to make necessary changes and resubmit. No changes may be made after this time, only scratches at the Coaches' meeting the day of the meet.

Psych sheets will be posted on www.swimcasl.org on Wednesday, July 18, 2012.

Officials:

Referees, Starters, Stroke & Turn officials, and Finish Judges will be provided by participating teams. These positions may be submitted on the attached volunteer form. **Timers:**

Two timers per lane will be used for all events with distances of 50 yards or more. In 25 yard events (8 & unders), three timers for each lane will be used. Please include timer names on the volunteer form.

Chaperones:

Two adult chaperones must be provided by each team to supervise swimmers in the team areas and assist in locating swimmers for the seeding area.

Seeding:

Event numbers will be posted and announced in the team areas. A seeding/staging area will be set up. Teams will be responsible for sending competitors to the seeding area when their event is posted and announced. Any swimmer who is not present at the seeding area and cannot be found will be scratched from the event. It is required that swimmers have footwear when going to and from their events. Baskets will be available at each lane for swimmers to place their towels, sweats, shoes, etc while they race.

Results:

Results will be posted as quickly as possible outside the pool area..

Awards:

1st -8th place shall receive awards. Coaches or league representatives are asked to pick up their awards at the end of the meet. Awards will not be distributed to athletes or family members.

All-Stars:

The first place finisher in each individual event will automatically qualify for the CASL All-Star Championships being held on Sunday, July 22 at Camp Hill. The next 12 fastest individuals and eight (8) relays from the combined divisional meet will also advance. Meet information and psych sheets will be available on the CASL web site www.swimcasl.org as printed and posted by the All-Star host.

Swimmers who place in the top 12 at the Divisional meet who do not intend to compete at All-Stars are asked to have their coach or team representative scratch that swimmer within one hour of the conclusion of the event. These scratches will be accepted at the scoring table.

Swim Vendor: A swim gear vendor will be selling swimwear and gear for purchase, and will be available throughout the meet.

Spectators:

Due to the limited seating area, we ask that seats not be saved throughout the meet. We appreciate spectators' cooperation so that everyone may enjoy seeing their swimmers compete. No folding chairs will be permitted in the pool area by spectators. Any spectators who require specific seating due to special needs should speak with a GETY volunteer or the Meet Director so that we can accommodate accordingly.

First Aid services will be available throughout the meet. Please see a GETY volunteer if first aid is needed.

Please refrain from using flash photography at the start of each event.

As with all swim meets, please remain quiet after the whistle blows for the swimmers to step on the starting blocks for the next event.

The meet venue area includes the pool, the main lobby area, the community room, the, locker rooms, and hallways connecting all these locations. (and if necessary the gymnasium)

Only swimmers competing or seeded in their events, team coaches, meet officials, and designated volunteers are allowed on the pool deck throughout the duration of the meet. All others will be asked to return to the team area.

General Rules: The Divisional Championship meet will be governed by the Capital Area Swim League rules.

Tobacco use is prohibited on YWCA property.

NO FOOD OR DRINKS, other than water, will be permitted in the pool, locker room, and gym areas. .

ALL SWIMMERS are to wear shoes or other footwear at all times when not competing to avoid injury. It is also required that swimmers have footwear when going to and from their events. Baskets will be available at each lane for swimmers to place their towels, sweats, shoes, etc while they race.

GETY will not be responsible for any lost or stolen items. Please make sure your swimmers keep track of their clothing and any other personal belongings.

Please keep the gym floor dry to avoid slips and injury. If you observe a wet area, please inform a GETY volunteer.

If weather forces indoor team areas, any chairs must have a towel or blanket under them to avoid marking the gym floor.

Coolers are not permitted in the gym or pool area.

Horseplay or games (football, basketball, etc.) will not be permitted in the facility

.

The seeding area must remain clear throughout the meet to maintain a steady flow of swimmer traffic.

Swimmers are requested to remain in their team area.

Locker room space is limited and is restricted to swimmers for restroom and changing purposes only.

Cell phones, cameras, and any recording devices will not be permitted in the locker rooms.

Coaches must monitor their team's warm-up session and control their warm-up procedure.

No diving in the shallow end of the pool. Feet first entry for warm-ups with the exception of starts at the conclusion of each warm-up session.

Please inspect your team area at the end of each session to ensure that all items have been removed and all trash is placed in trash containers.
