**Meet Start:**

**Eligibility:**

This meet is open to all registered CASL Division "A" swimmers who swam a minimum of three league meets throughout the season. Each swimmer may enter in a maximum of three events (3 individual **OR** 2 individual & 1 relay **OR** 1 individual and 2 relays). Swimmer's age is determined as of June 1, 2013.

### **Entries:**

Entries must be submitted to [schaeberled@yahoo.com](mailto:schaeberled@yahoo.com) using Hy-Tek software by 10:00pm of Sunday, July 14<sup>th</sup>. All times must be submitted in yards. If a yard time does not exist, please enter "NT" in the space provided. An entries report will be sent to each team for review and verification. No changes may be made after the entry report is verified.

### **Results/Awards:**

Results will be posted in the hallway for parents and swimmers to view. Ribbons will be awarded to the top six finishers in each event. A coach or parent representative must pick up their team's awards at the end of the meet.

### **Qualifying for All-Stars:**

Below are qualifying criteria for the All-Stars Championship meet:

- Top 8 relays across all 4 Divisions (A, AA, AAA, AAAA) Championship meets.
- Top 16 individuals across all 4 Divisions (A, AA, AAA, AAAA) with the individual winner from each Division Championship earning a guaranteed spot.

**\*Only times and finishes earned at each Division Championship will be used to determine qualification.**

### **Division Championship T-Shirts:**

Meet T-shirts will be available on pre-order. The cost is \$12.00 for a short sleeve T-shirt. **\*Attached Volunteer Registration Form must be completed and submitted by Entry deadline of Monday, July 15<sup>th</sup>. Teams who do not submit a volunteer registration form will not have their entries processed.**

### **Rules/Guidelines:**

- This meet will be governed by National Federation Rules, as amended by the Capital Area Swim League.
- All swimmers will be seated and staged in the gymnasium and then escorted to the pool deck.
- On-deck volunteers must check in with the volunteer coordinator at the beginning of the meet to receive their assignment and deck pass.
- Parents are NOT permitted on the pool deck during competition.
- Swimmers must enter the water feet first for warm-ups.
- False-Starts:
  - 8 & under – one (1) false start allowed
  - All other age groups – No (0) false starts allowed
- Dual confirmation will be used for all starts and relay take-offs.
- 8 & under relays will have the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> swimmers start from the water.
- Relay entries may include up to 8 swimmers.

### **Directions to our facility:**

**From the South:** Take I-83 North to Exit 24 (Emigsville Exit). Make a right turn at traffic light at the end of the ramp (Church Rd). Make a left turn onto N. George Street (Rt. 181 North) at the next traffic light. Proceed straight ahead to the 5th traffic light at the square in Manchester. Make a right turn onto Maple Street (HWY 921), go one block and make a left onto High Street. Travel approximately 1/2 mile to the high school, natatorium on right.

**From the North:** Take I-83 South to Exit 24 (Emigsville Exit). Turn left at the traffic light at end of exit ramp and proceed to second traffic light making a left turn onto N. George Street (Rt. 181 North). Proceed straight ahead to the 5th traffic light at the square in Manchester and make a right turn onto Maple Street (HWY 921), go one block and make a left onto High Street. Travel approximately 1/2 mile to the high school, natatorium on right.

**From the East:** Take Route 30 West to George Street. (Rt. 181 North), you will be turning right onto N. George Street from Route 30. Go through Emigsville towards Manchester. Proceed straight ahead to the 5th traffic light at the square in Manchester and make a right turn onto Maple Street (HWY 921), go one block and make a left onto High Street. Travel approximately 1/2 mile to the high school, natatorium on your right.

**From the West:** Take Route 30 East to George Street (Rt. 181 North), you will be turning left onto N. George Street from Route 30. Go through Emigsville towards Manchester. Proceed straight ahead to the 5th traffic light at the square in Manchester and make a right turn onto Maple Street (HWY 921), go one block and make a left onto High Street. Travel approximately 1/2 mile to the high school, natatorium on your right.
