FACILITIES	The Central York High School Natatorium is a state-of-the-art 40-yard indoor pool with adjustable bulkhead, which will be configured for eight 25-yard lanes for competition (13' depth at the start end and 7' depth at the turn end), and five additional lanes for continuous warm-up/ warm-down. Spectator gallery seating for 500; seating capacity for up to 300 athletes on the pool deck. The facility is equipped with AntiWave 6" Maximum racing lane lines, Spectrum Cougar starting blocks, Colorado 6 timing system, Aqua Grip touchpads, and an 8 x 7 ft. LED display board. The facility is also equipped with state-of-the-art filter and ventilation units, and an audio system with under water speakers. Parking is located next to the natatorium.

COORDINATORS	Four (4) timers per team and one (1) seeding or finish judge volunteer per team are required. Volunteers will receive <b>free admission</b> and a complementary meal from the concession stand.
ELIGIBILITY	Official results from each divisional championship meet will be compiled to determine the All-Stars qualifiers. The individual event champions from each divisional meet along with the next fastest 12 individual event times will qualify for individual events. The top sixteen (16) individuals and eight (8) relays from the combined results of the divisional meets will qualify. Individual event winners at the divisional meets earn an automatic berth to All-Stars. First and second alternates will be included in the final entry list.

There will be 13 lanes available for each session. Coaches and swimmers are asked to be courteous and fair to other teams in sharing lane space. Continuous warm-up/ warm-down will be available in the 5-lane portion of the pool throughout the meet.

	This meet will be conducted according to current NFHS swimming rules and safety procedures, with CASL modifications. This meet will be conducted using the whistle command and, with the exception of 8 & Under events, no-recall false start procedures.
RULES / SAFETY	No diving will be permitted during warm-ups, except limited diving from the starting block end in announced sprint lanes. When diving is permitted, the swimmer must enter from the starting block end and exit from the opposite end of the pool. All entries must be feet-first other than the above mentioned.
	Swimmers violating safety procedures will be removed from the warm-up

RULES / SAFETY con't	for the remainder of the warm-up session. Subsequent violations may cause the swimmer to be disqualified from the remainder of the meet.  SWIMMER OBSERVED SWIMMING UNDER THE BULKHEAD BY AN OFFICIAL OR SAFETY MONITOR AT THE MEET WILL BE DISQUALIFIED FROM THAT SWIMMER'S NEXT INDIVIDUAL EVENT, OR FROM THE REMAINDER OF THE MEET, AS DETERMINED BY THE MEET REFEREE. THIS POLICY WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.  NO SPECTATORS WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE POOL DECK AT ANY TIME. Swimmers are not permitted to be in the spectator seating unless they are dried and fully clothed. Swimmers and parents may meet in the lobby of the building.  Deck access is limited to swimmers, coaches, officials and meet volunteers.	
	Officials, coaches, and volunteers will be given wristbands which must be worn to be permitted on the pool deck.  RECORDING BAN – The use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, restrooms, locker rooms, or behind the starting blocks.	
EVENTS / SESSIONS	The order of events is attached. The meet will be run as two sessions, with 8 & Under and 9-10 year old swimmers competing in the AM session and 11 & 12, 13-14 and 15-18 year old swimmers competing in the afternoon session.	
SWIMMERS WITH DISABILITIES	A coach or team representative must alert the meet director and the meet referee as to the need for any special accommodations or arrangements prior to the start of the meet.	
SWIMMER SEATING	Swimmer seating will be available on the pool deck, as well as in the gymnasium.	
AWARDS	Custom medals will be awarded to places 1st through 8th for relay events and 1st through 16th for individual events. Champions of each event will receive a custom CASL All-Star Champion swim cap. Coaches must pick up their team's awards at the conclusion of the meet.	
LIVE RESULTS	Results will be posted throughout the meet for parents and swimmers to view. Live results will be available at <a href="http://www.swimdover.org/realtime/">http://www.swimdover.org/realtime/</a> as well as through the Meet Mobile app available for iPhone and Android. Results will be provided electronically to any coach who brings a flash drive.	
PROGRAMS & ADMISSION	Admission \$5.00. Children under 5 admitted free. Free admission to all volunteers. One meet program per family will be included in the cost of admission.	
VENDORS / CONCESSIONS	A complete selection of food and drinks will be available for purchase at the concession stand located in the cafeteria. Vendors will be on-site, selling meet t-shirts and swimming equipment.  * Food is NOT permitted on the pool deck, gym or spectator area
