First and second alternates for both leagues will be included in the final entry list. Please contact the meet director with any last minute scratches.

	BREAK/WARM-UP: There will be a meet break after event #38 (Girls 15-18 backstroke). At this time the upper pool will be open as follows: Diving lanes 5 and 6; General Warm up lanes 1-4.

DIRECTIONS TO DTRC	From Harrisburg to 605 Cocoa Ave, Hershey PA: Traveling East on 322/422 they split just before the Hershey Park Exit. Take the 322 East/Ephrata Exit (W. Governor Rd) which bears to the right. This will take you past the Hershey Medical Center. Continue on W. Governor Rd. ~2.0 miles until you get to Cocoa Ave. (The 5th light on W. Governor Rd, old white hotel on right, Antique Barn on left) Turn left on Cocoa and travel ~0.3 mile. On your right is the Hershey Parks & Recreation facility. Plenty of parking in the rear.			
ARRIVAL AND PARKING	PARKING: Available in the DTRC lot for 200 vehicles. Overflow parking will be at the Hershey Public Library (on Cocoa Ave.) next to the Recreation Center, parking lots at the schools located behind the Recreation Center (from the pool, turn right onto Cocoa Ave., right onto Areba Ave., right onto Homestead, and proceed to the entrance of the elementary or middle school parking lots) and on the streets where parking is permitted.
