2023 CAPITAL AREA SWIM LEAGUE AAA DIVISIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP MEET

@ Dover Area Aquatic Club July 22, 2023

Location

The meet will be conducted at the Dover Area High School Pool of the Dover Area School District. The High School is located at 4500 Intermediate Ave. Please park in the front lot of the high school and enter the building through the main entrance. The natatorium is located in the back of the building as you walk through the cafeteria area.

Facilities

The pool is six lanes with a separate cool down/warm up area. A Colorado automatic timing system will be used. Teams will be housed in an adjacent gymnasium. Each team must supply one or two responsible adults to supervise and move swimmers to the seeding area on time. Locker rooms will be available for changing clothes only. No musical devices will be permitted to be played in the gymnasium. A concession stand will be in operation throughout the meet. Food and drink are permitted only in the cafeteria area of the school. Please do not take food or drinks into the pool, pool balcony, or gymnasium.

Eligibility

A swimmer must swim in their true age level as of June 1, 2023. A swimmer must have swum in 3 meets sponsored by the league in order to be eligible for the championship meet. Invitational meets can count toward 3 meets required.

Entries Deadline

Sunday, July 16, 2023 – 7:00 PM

Entries

A swimmer may enter three events. A swimmer may swim up age groups in relay events only. A maximum of 2 relay entries in each age group will be permitted per team. Team Manager export file of your team entries must be e-mailed to <a href="maileo-response-

Rules

National Federation Rules will govern the meet along with any Capital Area Swim League By-Laws.

Awards

Ribbons will be given to first through eighth places.

Meet Start time and Warmup Times

Proper footwear should be brought to walk to the pool through the school halls. No chairs should be placed directly on the gymnasium floor. Please place any chairs on top of a blanket or towel. Each Team should designate 1-2 parent volunteers to help direct swimmers from their team to the seeding area in the gym.

Concession Stand

A concession stand will be in operation throughout the meet. Food and drink are permitted in the cafeteria area only of the school. In addition, **no outside food may be brought into the gym or pool areas.** Everyone's cooperation in this request will be greatly appreciated.

Officials

Each team will need to provide two trained stroke and turn officials. Please provide the names of the two officials for your team on the form at the end of this document.

Timers

Each team must supply six timers for the entire meet. You will be assigned a lane for the entire meet and we will switch timers halfway through the meet.
